Luisa Pais Lowe is currently the Consul General of Portugal in New York. She joined the Portuguese Foreign Service in early 1989 and holds the ranking of Minister Plenipotentiary. She served as Chargée d’Affaires of Portugal in Slovenia, Consul General of Portugal in Hamburg, Senior Political Counselor at the Embassy of Portugal in Washington, D.C., Deputy Permanent Representative of Portugal to the Organization for Cooperation and Security in Europe (OSCE) in Vienna, and Political Officer at the Embassy of Portugal in Bonn. She also held short-term commissions in the Permanent Missions of Portugal to the United Nations in New York and Geneva.

In Portugal, she worked as Diplomatic Adviser to the Prime Minister, Economic Adviser to the Secretary of State for Portuguese Communities and Director of the Department for Portuguese Diaspora Investment and Entrepreneurship. She also held various managing positions in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, most notably in the Department of European Affairs (Central, Eastern and Southeastern Europe) and at the United Nations Department (Human Rights).
